

CORPORATION OF THE COUNTY OF PRINCE EDWARD

BYLAW NO. 643 -2001

BEING A BYLAW TO PROHIBIT THE LITTERING ON PRIVATE OR MUNICIPAL PROPERTY AND TO REPEAL ALL BYLAWS OF THE FORMER MUNICIPALITIES AND THIS MUNICIPALITY THAT DEAL WITH THIS SUBJECT.

WHEREAS Section 210(82) of the Municipal Act, R.S.O. 1990, Chapter M45, as amended, empowers Municipalities to pass bylaws prohibiting the throwing, placing or depositing of refuse or debris on private property or on property of the Municipality or any local board thereof without authority from the owner or occupant of such property;

AND WHEREAS, Section 320 of the Municipal Act, R.S.O. 1990, Chapter M45, as amended, empowers Municipalities to pass bylaws to impose fines if any person contravenes any bylaw of the Municipality approved under the authority of the Municipal Act;

AND WHEREAS, Section 8(1)(a) of the Minister's Order dated March 27, 1997 permits the repeal of any bylaw of the former Municipalities within Prince Edward County;

AND WHEREAS, the Council for The Corporation of the County of Prince Edward deems it advisable to prohibit littering on public or private property within the County of Prince Edward;

NOW THEREFORE the Council for the Corporation of the County of Prince Edward enacts as follows:


1. That from and after the passing of this by-law, no person shall throw, place or deposit refuse or debris on private property or on property of the Municipality or any local board thereof without the authority from the owner or occupant of such property.
2. Every person who contravenes any provision of this by-law is guilty of an offence and on conviction is liable to a fine as provided for in the Provincial Offences Act.
3. That the following bylaws are hereby repealed.

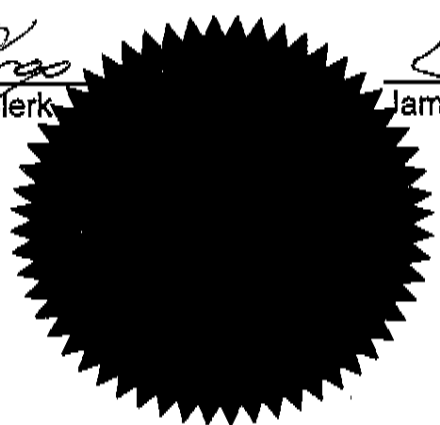
