

THE CORPORATION OF THE COUNTY OF PRINCE EDWARD

BY-LAW NO. 1977 -2007

---

**A BY-LAW TO AMEND BY-LAW 643-2001, BEING A BY-LAW TO PROHIBIT THE LITTERING ON PRIVATE OR MUNICIPAL PROPERTY.**

---

**WHEREAS** Section 10 (2) of the Municipal Act, 2001, S.O. 2001, c.25, as amended, municipalities may pass by-laws respecting economic, social and environmental well-being of the municipality and structures, including fences and signs.

**WHEREAS** the Council of the Corporation of the County of Prince Edward adopted By-law 643-2001 which prohibited the throwing, placing or depositing of refuse or debris on private property or on property of the Municipality or any local board thereof with out authority from the owner or occupant of such property.

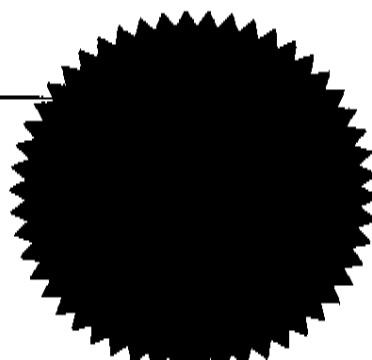
**AND WHEREAS** the Council of the Corporation of the County of Prince Edward desires to amend By-law 643-2001 known as the Littering By-law, to include requirements for all Drive Through and Take Out Restaurants to display a No Littering Sign that indicates a maximum fine for littering in the County of Prince Edward.


**NOW THEREFORE** the Council of the Corporation of the County of Prince Edward enacts as follows:

1. **THAT** By-law 643-2001 be amended by deleting Clause 1 and inserting in lieu there of the following:
  - "1 a) **THAT** from and after the passing of this by-law, no person shall throw, place or deposit refuse or debris on private property or on property of the Municipality or any local board thereof without the authority from the owner or occupant or such property.
  - b) **THAT** all Drive Through and Take Out Restaurants display a No Littering Sign that indicates that the maximum fine for littering is \$3,000.00, and that the sign is clearly visible from vehicles going through the Drive Through Restaurant.
  - c) **THAT** all Drive Through and Take Out Restaurants be required to post a No Littering Sign a minimum size of 2 square feet/0.6 square metres at the point of purchase, or inside the restaurant and clearly visible to the purchaser.
  - d) **THAT** the minimum wording requirement, colour and size of the No Littering signs be determined by the County Planning Department and By-law Officers.
  - e) **THAT** a definition of a Take Out Restaurant include a chip truck type vehicle.
  - f) **THAT** a Part 2 Fine Schedule be obtained for first time offences."
2. **THAT** the provisions of this by-law shall come into force and effect upon the date of final passage thereof.

Read a first, second and third time and finally passed this 25th day of June, 2007.
