PROCLAMATION

Wednesday, November 1, 2017 is “Miss Supertest” Day

WHEREAS, on November 1, 1957 the Canadian Unlimited Class Hydroplane “Miss Supertest II” achieved the official world water speed record of 184.4 mph along the Canadian Boating Federation officially sanctioned 7 mile-long course along (Hayward) Long Reach in Prince Edward County; and

WHEREAS this speed record is recognized by the Union Internationale Motonautique (UIM), the world governing body for all powerboating activities; and

WHEREAS this historical event was recognized locally and internationally by way of newspaper headlines, radio and TV reports; and

WHEREAS this speed record still stands – 60 years later - as the Official Canadian Water Speed Record;

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT I, Robert L. Quaiff, Mayor of The Corporation of the County of Prince Edward, do hereby proclaim Wednesday, November 1, 2017 as “Miss Supertest” Day in the County of Prince Edward.
