## PROCLAMATION

### Wednesday, November 1, 2017 is “Miss Supertest” Day

**WHEREAS**, on November 1, 1957 the Canadian Unlimited Class Hydroplane “Miss Supertest II” achieved the official world water speed record of 184.4 mph along the Canadian Boating Federation officially sanctioned 7 mile-long course along (Hayward) Long Reach in Prince Edward County; and

**WHEREAS** this speed record is recognized by the Union Internationale Motonautique (UIM), the world governing body for all powerboating activities; and

**WHEREAS** this historical event was recognized locally and internationally by way of newspaper headlines, radio and TV reports; and

**WHEREAS** this speed record still stands – 60 years later - as the Official Canadian Water Speed Record;

**THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT** I, Robert L. Quaiff, Mayor of The Corporation of the County of Prince Edward, do hereby proclaim Wednesday, November 1, 2017 as “Miss Supertest” Day in the County of Prince Edward.
