Brief Description of Work

The Watermain Improvements and Illuminated Sidewalk scope will comprise of:

- Installation of new, and/or replacement of approximately 1,600m of watermain on Union Street, Church Street, Old Church Street and County Road 22, to connect to the Picton Heights Reservoir in the Town of Picton. Portions of the watermain may require trenchless technology.
- Construction of approximately 1,000m of concrete sidewalk, complete with new light poles/light attachments for illumination
- Clearing, grubbing, tree protection, environmental protection, sedimentation and erosion control
- Site works, grading and local landscaping
- Road restoration

All tenders to be accompanied by a BID DEPOSIT for the amount of 10% of the total tender price IN THE FORM OF a Certified Cheque or Bid Bond payable to the Corporation of the County of Prince Edward. Lowest or any tender may not necessarily be accepted.
